What does the job entail?

The communications team is part of the Department of Programmes & Partnerships (P&P) and operates from the office in Brussels. Your report to the head of P&P and you work closely with the other team coordinators within P&P (Knowledge Management, Programme Management, Resource Mobilisation).

You manage a team of 2 (internal resp. External) communication experts and will be working with 7 communication advisors overseas. You are (often together with others) responsible for realizing integrated communication projects.

Your main responsibilities include

- preparing and managing the communication budget
- coaching and managing the team
- managing the processes around the new branding and the renewed website

- coordination & content creation of the Trias website

- You have a Master's degree in a relevant domain, or equivalent through experience;
- You gained relevant work experience for a minimum of 8 years;
- You have experience in managing and coaching teams for a minimum of 3 years;
- You can express yourself fluently in English, both spoken and written; knowledge of French,
 Spanish, Portuguese or Dutch is an added value;
- You master the use of Microsoft Office and other virtual tools;
- You have experience in graphic design and public relations;
- You combine conceptual thinking with a hands-on mentality;
- You are up to date with the latest communication trends;
- You have an affinity with our sector and the ability to collaborate with various teams.

What can we offer you?

We offer a job in a dynamic and challenging environment in an international context.

You will receive a contract for an indefinite period, with flexible teleworking options.
