As part of the development team (currently two staff -Michael and Serge- hosted at Fairtrade Belgium) and in close coordination with the product owner and support team ((Neal, Sophie) hosted at Max Havelaar France), you will play a key role in the maintenance and development of the application.

Your Mission

- You will be in **contact with Fairtrade Organizations in more than 25 countries**, for the technical and functional aspects of a custom line-of-business web application known as 'Fairtrade Connect'.
- You will provide **3rd line technical support, troubleshoot and qualify incidents, and supervise and implement resolution** (1st line is with the local country, 2nd line is functional support, initial qualification & dispatching).
- You will **actively contribute to the developments and coding (in-house)**, with support from the team, in accordance with development priorities coordinated by the product owner
- You will be **designing and building application layers**
- You will be **writing test-backed server-side code**
- You will be analysing requirements and designing new functionality

Your Profile

- You are 'tech-savvy', you like to experiment with innovative technologies, and are a fast learner.
- You have a **deep understanding of Data and are capable of structuring/modelling data** to meet business requirements.
- You have proficient knowledge in **Object Oriented programming and the C# language**.
